Toledo Police Continue to Investigate Three Deceased People in As Many Days

Toledo, OH (November 13, 2019): In the past several days, there have been three deceased people found in Toledo.

November 9, 2019: A deceased woman was found in a field near Kuhlman Drive and South. She was later identified as Michelle Keagler. The Lucas County Deputy Coroner stated that she had been stabbed 24 times. Detectives are still working on determining if the attack occurred in the field where the victim was found or if the crime occurred at a different location and the victim was left in the field. This death is being investigated as a homicide. However, it is not considered a random attack.

November 10, 2019: An unidentified female was dropped off by private automobile to St. Vincent's Hospital. The woman was pronounced deceased shortly after. Detectives have potentially identified the woman, but are waiting for confirmation from the Lucas County Coroner's office. There were no immediate signs of trauma on her body.

November 11, 2019: A deceased male was found underneath the High Level Bridge. The male is believed to be missing 17-year old Damian Henning, who was listed as missing from Huron County. His cause of death has yet to be determined, pending autopsy. His vehicle was located within the immediate vicinity of where he was found.

Every death is a tragic loss of life and many hours go into investigations, especially those of deceased persons. Police work takes time and results are rarely immediate. It is important to remember to fact check posts that are being circulated on social media. Detectives continue to work the cases of the deceased people and when there are updates, Toledo Police will share them. All three deaths are unrelated.

There have been 29 homicides in Toledo this year, 5 remain unsolved. This time last year, there were 36 homicides.
