LETTER FROM CHIEF KRAL

Toledo Residents,

I am pleased to present to all of you the second iteration of the Chief's Advisory Board (CAB) Survey – Report to the Community.

The plan was always to revisit the original 2017 survey a few years after it was initially offered to the community. The thought process was, what good would this initial survey be if we never checked with the residents of Toledo to see if we are improving?

When the survey was initially completed there were less than 900 surveys completed. This time, more than 1,300 surveys were completed! I want to thank all of you who took time out of your day to provide us with your feedback. We all must remember that we are here to serve you. Without knowing what you want your police department to concentrate on it is impossible for me to satisfy your desires.

As I said last time, in my more than 30 years with TPD, I have never seen a survey of this depth conducted. I want to thank the members of CAB for their guidance and assistance in the formation of this survey. It could not have happened without them. Special thanks need to go out to Dr. Kasey Tucker-Gail, Dr. David Lilley, and Dr. Megan Stewart, from the University of Toledo for development of the survey format. Additionally, Ms. Holly Matthews, Executive Director of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council, for summarizing the results in a "citizen friendly" report.

We at the CAB and TPD are committed to increasing the trust of the citizens of this city. TPD cannot police this city alone. We must work together, neighborhood-by-neighborhood addressing what is important to the residents. Then, and only then, will we see true results: safer, more livable communities. I am confident that we are heading in the right direction.

Finally, when the COVID-19 pandemic ends, we will continue to hold Town Hall Meetings, asking and listening to the comments and feedback of Toledo's residents. I say this constantly, it truly is a privilege and honor to be Toledo's Police Chief.

Thank you again for the opportunity to serve all of you and work with you to make Toledo a better place to live.





Age of Respondents










Respondents Residence




Respondent Years Living in the City of Toledo






Respondents Education





How satisfied are you with police services in Toledo?




How air do you think the Toledo Police are in their dealings with people?





Do you think that a formal complaint filed against a Toledo Police officer will be taken seriously?










Satisfaction with response time?



How Safe Do You Feel In Your Neighborhood?











Do you feel that the level of crime in your neighborhood has







What concerns you the most in your neighborhood?













How familiar are you with your neighborhood association?







What was the nature of the contact with TPD?










In your opinion, how large of a problem are drug sales and/or use in your neighborhood?







How large of a problem is ____ in your neighborhood?



Ways you have used the Toledo Police Department's Website




What would be the best way for the City of Toledo to pass out important information?
